Mentors: Actors & Improv students - Grades 9-12. Maximum 3. Actor mentors must have experience comparable to at least one year in Acting 2 or Acting 3. Improv. mentors must have attended at least one year of Improv classes.

NO cost for **Mentors**, who must contact me for approval by email, no later than the Commitment Date in #11 below. Mentors will have a prime opportunity to work with young actors (great fun!) and gain resume-boosting experience while earning community service hours. By agreement with me and a parent, Mentors can work flexibly during some/all of the four days.

* Camp Contents: The Camp will include Improv overtones, and participants will learn stagecraft (how to move confidently around an Acting or Improv space and heard/seen clearly on stage) and how to create and perform vivid characters - script-based and improvised.

NO line learning, lots of theatre games & introductory improvisations, & plenty of great collaborative, creative fun reading/performing age-appropriate short scenes/monologues
